4. Attach a one-page essay (10-point font, single-spaced) addressing the following question: What steps will you take to convey the knowledge learned on the study tour to Germany and Poland to the students in your school and to your colleagues?

Each participant will be required to

- Keep a journal during the trip and write a reflection upon return;
- Write a "unit of learning," consisting of one or more lessons on the Holocaust or human rights, and
- Conduct one workshop at the department, local or state level during the 2012 - 2013 school year.
- Make a commitment to the HHREC Education Program Committee by contributing to the work of one of its subcommittees: Student Institute, Survivor Legacy Program, Focus Seminars, Professional Development Initiatives, etc.
